We are the most comprehensive human service provider serving people in all eight counties of Western New York.

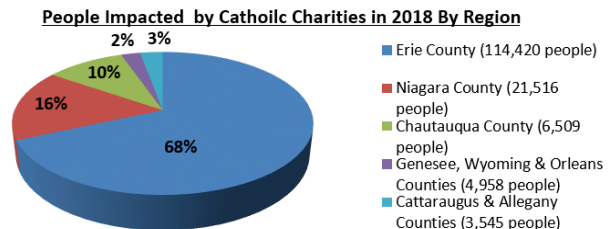
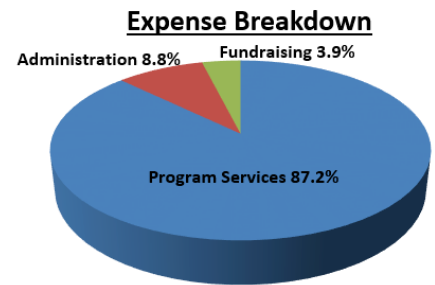
